Mafeking is the home of Rover Motorsport in Victoria and the host location for the upcoming 2016 Australian Rover Moot 'The Moot'.

The opportunity:

The Committee is seeking a Rover to join the committee to fulfil the role of Business Plan and Knowledge Management Officer. This role is open to all Rovers currently registered within Victoria who may be interested in driving the strategic planning for the Park and maintaining documentation about Park operations.

What's in it for you?

The Park has been in the process of developing their Business and Strategic Plan for the next five years. This plan will guide committee decisions in the direction of Mafeking long term, including infrastructure development projects, marketing plans, and ensure the growth and development of Mafeking as one of the premier campsites within Victoria long term.

The Business Plan and Knowledge Management Officer will drive this project, with the aim of a completed document being tabled at the Victorian Rover Council within the 2016-17 term. This role is also involved in maintaining and developing the documentation of all aspects of the Park and would play an important role in the current development projects onsite.

What skills do you need?

In order for you to be considered for the role the applicant must be a current invested Rover and will remain so for the duration of the term.

This role is ideal for someone who is organised and details focused. Strong oral and written communication skills, as well as an ability to work in a team environment would be beneficial to anyone in the role.

This role will be reporting to the Vice Chairman (Administration) and will be expected to prepare a report on a monthly basis in regards to works completed and underway.
