The opportunity:

The Committee seeks a Rover to join the committee to fulfil the role of Fire Prevention Officer; this role is open to all Rovers currently registered within Victoria who have an interest in fulfilling the role. The role of the Fire Prevention Officer is to develop and manage a fuel reduction plan for the Park and to minimise the risk of any fire damage to the property.

What's in it for you?

Mafeking's large acreage and varying terrain presents unique challenges and opportunities in managing and reducing fuel load across the Park. With the upcoming National Moot over the summer of 2016-17 this role takes on increased significance as the committee work to reduce the risk of fire for a large event to be held during summer.

Working with the Environment Officer and other members of the Operations team this position presents an opportunity work with local fire authorities and develop skills in planning and undertaking fuel reduction burns.

What skills do you need?

This role is ideal for someone with CFA or other fire fighting experience. In order for you to be considered for the role the applicant must be a current invested Rover and will remain so for the duration of the term. An understanding of the permit requirements for burning off is essential.

This role will be reporting to the Vice Chairman (Operations) and will be expected to prepare a report on a monthly basis in regards to works completed and underway.
